Hurricanes _____^{Verb} in a counterclockwise direction around an "eye." A tropical _____^{Noun} becomes a hurricane when winds reach _____^{Number} mph. There are on average six Atlantic hurricanes each _____^{Period of time}; over a three-year period, approximately five _____^{Plural noun} strike the United States coastline from Texas to _____^{Location}. The Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30. The East Pacific _____^{Noun} season runs from May 15 through November 30, with peak activity occurring during July through September. In a _____^{Adjective} _____^{Noun} the East Pacific would expect 15 or 16 tropical storms. _____^{Number} of these would become hurricanes, of which four or five would be _____^{Adjective} hurricanes.
