## **Installing a Toilet**

Insert the long <u>Adjective</u> closet bolts, threaded-end up, into the flange collar's slots. Slip a brass Noun over each. Gently press a <u>Adjective</u> <u>Noun</u>, flat-side down, over the flange. Lift the toilet bowl over the flange, align the holes in its base with the closet bolts, and lower the base onto the Repeat Last Noun Without twisting or rocking, press the bowl down onto the Repeat Last Adjective Repeat Last Noun until the bowl's base rests on the floor. If the floor is uneven, shim the bowl with a stainless steel \_\_\_\_\_\_. Slip a nylon washer over each bolt, then \_\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_ the nuts. Repeat Last Verb - Base Form the nuts with a Noun one quarter turn at a time, alternating between the two. Stop when the Repeat Last Noun meets firm resistance; overtightening will crack the bowl. With a hacksaw, trim the closet bolts at a point two threads above the top of the nut. Snap a Adjective

<u>Noun</u> into place.
