## **The Four Children**

The wise child asks, "What are the Noun, the Noun, and the laws that God has commanded
you to do?" You should reply to him with the laws of pesach: one may not any dessert any dessert
after the paschal sacrifice.
The wicked asks, "What is this service to you?" The child is not including himself and has
withdrawn himself from the Jewish community. He is rebuked with the Noun that "It is because God
acted for my sake when I left Egypt." The Seder is not for the child and there would not have
been redemption for him.
The simple Noun Verb - Present ends in S "What is this?" You reply, "With a strong hand the
Almighty led us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage."
The child who is too to ask is told the of Passover "because of what the
Almighty did for me when I left Egypt."
