A former Silly word High School teacher and girls Noun coach charged with Number counts of sexual assault in three counties Past tense verb today to enter a Noun to a charge of exposing a child to harmful Plural noun.

He was a Occupation and coach at West De Pere, Noun Bay Southwest and Noun high schools over the past Noun years. Criminal complaints in Brown and Silly word counties accuse him of sexual relationships with Plural noun pressuring other students into starting Plural noun and exchanging sexual photos and e-mail messages with students.

The

girl, now 18, told police Zellner gave her his Noun phone number during the 2007-08 school year and began sending Noun messages of a Adjective nature. She told police she sent Zellner Plural noun of herself and received several photos of Zellner's Body part the criminal complaint says.

The girl, who was a sophomore during the year of the Noun exchanges, said she still had the data card from the cellular Noun. A Occupation found two photos of an Body part and a third photo of a man pulling down Color Article of clothing plural to expose a pair of blue and Color striped Article of clothing plural.

When police searched Zellner's home, they found a pair of striped Noun Plural noun of the same colors that had the same Plural noun as the pair in the picture. The red athletic shorts worn by Zellner when he was taken to the Silly word County Jail also resembled the Article of clothing plural in the photo, the complaint says.
