How to tie a shoe

the Noun. Before you start to Verb the shoe, make sure that the laces are Adjective.

You can check for Adjective laces by pulling up both ends Adverb to the shoe.

Verb the laces. Cross the strings and lay them down on the Noun. Bring one string under the other and Verb.

Form a loop in one hand. Verb opposite string around the loop once and pull that string through the loop, creating Number loops. Verb both loops.

Verb your Noun out. Pull out the Noun of the shoe position it comfortably on the Noun.

. If you want the shoes to stayed tied, you can create a Noun. Hold both loops and Verb. Bring one

loop through the "hole"; and Verb.
