# Seasons

A season is one of the major divisions of the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun generally based on yearly periodic changes in \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. Seasons happen due to the yearly \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of the \_\_\_\_\_ Proper noun and the Sun and the tilt of the \_\_\_\_\_ proper noun plural axis relative to the plane of revolution in \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective and Polar regions, the seasons are made by change in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun which may cause animals to go into hibernation or \_\_\_\_\_ Verb and plants to be dormant In Temperate and Polar regions generally our seasons are \_\_\_\_\_ Past tense verb Spring, \_\_\_\_\_ Proper noun Autumn and \_\_\_\_\_ Proper noun.

In some Tropical and Subtropical \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun it is more common to speak of the rainy \_\_\_\_\_ Noun versus the dry \_\_\_\_\_ noun because the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of precipitation may vary more dramatically than the average \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. In other \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective regions a three-way \_\_\_\_\_ Noun into hot, rainy and cool \_\_\_\_\_ Plural noun is used. In some parts of the world, \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective 'seasons' are loosely defined upon \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective events such as hurricane, tornado and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun season.
