Winterize your Boat

1. According to the instructions on the bottle, pour the correct amount of <u>Adjective</u> <u>Plural noun</u> into the boat gas tank.

3. Start the boat motor and pour 1/2 gallon the of the antifreeze into the water intake. This will clear out any

 that may be left in the motor from your last use, and will also allow the fuel stabilizer to

4. Stop the boat motor.

6. Remove the <u>Adjective</u> wires from the battery terminals, then remove the battery from the boat.

7. Place the battery in a heated area such as your <u>Adjective</u> Noun for the winter.

8. Remove all spark plug/ignition wires from the spark plugs, then remove all <u>Noun</u> plugs from the engine cylinders.

9. Place 1 or <u>Number</u> drops of oil into the cylinders through the spark plug holes. From what I hear, this can actually prevent small amounts of oxidation by allowing the oil to collect <u>Plural noun</u> that may develop in the cylinders.

10. Put the spark plugs back in the cylinders, but <u>Verb</u> the <u>Adjective</u> Plural noun.
