How to Open your Swimming Pool

The first thing on the list is to remove the swimming pool cover. If there are leaves or other debris on the cover,

use your Adjective Noun to remove them.

After removing the cover, be sure to Verb - Base Form it, Verb - Base Form it , and store for the season.

Remove any freeze plugs, Noun - Plural, and other items installed to protect against freezing.

You should have cleaned your filter thoroughly when you closed the pool for the winter. If not, you should

Verb - Base Form yourself now.

Now, start your filter system up, being sure to Verb - Base Form the pump before starting the motor. Be sure

to purge all the Noun - Plural from the plumbing and equipment .

After cleaning the pool, it's time to check the water chemistry.

Allow the water to circulate at least Number hours, so that the water that was added has time to mix with the water in the pool.

After

that time, test it thoroughly, then add the necessary _____ Noun - Plural in the proper sequence to balance the

water chemistry. We suggest taking a water sample to your local pool professional to have it tested for
