The first thing on the list is to remove the swimming pool cover. If there are leaves or other debris on the cover, use your _____ Adjective _____ Noun to remove them.

Remove any freeze plugs, _____ Noun - Plural, and other items installed to protect against freezing.

You should have cleaned your filter thoroughly when you closed the pool for the winter. If not, you should _____ Verb - Base Form yourself now.

After cleaning the pool, it's time to check the water chemistry.

that time, test it thoroughly, then add the necessary _____ Noun - Plural in the proper sequence to balance the water chemistry.
