# The Second Half of the Bill of Rights

In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective and \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective trial, by an \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective jury of the state and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, which district shall have been previously ascertained by law, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; to be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense with the witnesses against him; to have compulsory process for \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present \_\_\_\_\_ ends in ING witnesses in his favor, and to have the assistance of counsel for his defense.

In suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Number dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense, and no fact tried by a jury, shall be otherwise \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense in any court of the United States, than according to the rules of the common law.

The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense by the people.

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the states, are reserved to the states \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb, or to the people.
