Information about Tornadoes

During a tornado always make sure you are in a/an Adjective area with no Noun - Plural so you will be safe from Verb - Present ends in ING Noun - Plural. Good places to Verb - Base Form are cellars, Noun - Plural, Noun - Plural, and closets. If you have a weather Noun with you, you may be able to get a Noun with the Adjective Noun Service. If you have a Noun cellar, go in there.

Tornadoes can be Single, or Multi Vortex. They also come in different varieties, F1 T1 for the Adjective ones, and F5 and T11 for the Adjective. If you cannot Verb - Base Form Noun, if there is a Type of Vehicle nearby, Verb - Base Form in it and Verb - Base Form AWAY from the Noun.
