Facial Injury MadLib

Pt. is a Number Number y/o Adjective water polo player named Proper Noun Proper Noun - Plural. Pt c/o severe P! in face and head, trouble breathing through nose, and tinnitus in L ear.

MOI: Pt reports being hit in the face with a Noun when he was standing on the edge of the pool. The hit knocked him into the pool, and he landed flat on the L side of his Noun. Pt reports P! 7/10 across nose and zygomatic arch, and severe P! 9/10 in L ear. Pt describes pressure in head like Noun sitting on his face, along with a Sign of Concussion, and sensitivity to light and sound. Pt often experiences periods of Sign of Concussion and Sign of Concussion, and is having trouble reading and Verb - Present Tense.

Pt has PMH of two concussions. Pt is allergic to tree nuts, Noun, and sulfa-drugs.
