# Splash Mountain

After a \_\_\_\_\_ drop down " \_\_\_\_\_ Falls", guests enter the \_\_\_\_\_ portion of the attraction, where various \_\_\_\_\_ animals, such as \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ sing the attraction's first \_\_\_\_\_ number, "How Do You \_\_\_\_\_?".

Most of the animals on \_\_\_\_\_ Mountain were reused from the closed attraction \_\_\_\_\_ Sings. Brer Rabbit (voiced by \_\_\_\_\_ Harnell) is seen \_\_\_\_\_ at Brer \_\_\_\_\_, preceding a " \_\_\_\_\_" into the surreal Rainbow Caverns, where characters sing "Everybody's Got a Laughin' \_\_\_\_\_."

Brer \_\_\_\_\_ then manages to trap Brer \_\_\_\_\_ in a beehive. The mood turns \_\_\_\_\_ as two mother characters sing the " \_\_\_\_\_ Lament." The collective weight of the riders generally determines the degree to which they get wet here.
