The US Constitution

We the Noun - Plural of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Proper Noun, establish Justice, Verb - Non 3rd Person Singular Present domestic Tranquility, Verb for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Noun to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United Proper Noun of Proper Noun.

Article. Roman Numeral.

Section. Number.

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Noun and House of Noun - Plural.

Section. 2.

The House of Noun - Plural shall be composed of Noun - Plural chosen every second Year by the People of the several Noun - Plural, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most Adjective Branch of the State Noun.

No Noun shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Noun - Plural, and been Number Years a Noun of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Noun of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Noun - Plural and direct Taxes shall be Verb - Past Tense among the several Noun - Plural

which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be Verb -

Past Tense

by adding to the Adjective Number of free Noun - Plural, including those bound to Noun
for a Term of Number, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Noun - Plural.
