All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a _____ Noun _____ of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

The House of Representatives shall be _____ Verb - Past Tense _____ of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the _____ Noun _____ requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of _____ Number _____ Number _____ Years, and been _____ Number _____ Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and _____ Adjective _____ Taxes shall be _____ Verb - Past Tense _____ among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the

whole Number of _____ Adjective Persons, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.² The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed one for every _____ Number Thousand, but each State shall have at Least one Representative; and until such enumeration shall be made, the State of New Hampshire shall be entitled to chuse three, Massachusetts eight, _____ Location and Providence Plantations one, Connecticut five, New-York six, New Jersey four, Pennsylvania eight, Delaware one, _____ Location six, Virginia ten, North Carolina _____ Number, South Carolina five, and Georgia three.
