# Rules of Sterile Technique

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Noun is the #1 way to decrease infection
2. Never wear \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and keep your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural short
3. Wear the indicated personal protective equipment
4. Long \_\_\_\_\_ Noun should be pulled back
5. Always \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form before you touch something (To touch something sterile you must use something sterile)
6. Remember only the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of you from the waist up is sterile!!
7. Do not drop your hands below your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun or cross your \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural!!
8. Discard \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective objects immediately
9. When in doubt throw it out!
10. When something \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in S its not sterile
11. When throwing things away always use the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective technique
12. Never do the following in the sterile field: \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form, \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form, \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form, and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form too much
