<u>Same Prover Noun from earlier</u> was born in 406 and in 434, at the age of 28, <u>Same Prover Noun from earlier</u> at first ruled with his brother, <u>Sameone in this room</u>, but murdered <u>Someone in this room</u> in 445 to take complete control.
