## Chupacabra

The most common <u>Adjective</u> description of chupacabras is a <u>Adjective</u> reptile-like creature, appearing to have <u>Adjective</u> leathery or scaly greenish-gray skin and sharp <u>Adjective</u> spines or quills running down its <u>Noun</u>.
