NASCAR

Ralph Dale Earnhardt Sr. was a NASCAR Noun who became famous for his Adjective rsum in Proper Noun Cup racing in the 1980s and 1990s. Earnhardt Verb - Past Tense seven Noun - Plural during that time, tied for most all time, and was named driver of the year four times. He was known as "The Intimidator" for his Adjective -- and Adjective -- driving style.

Earnhardt died Feb. 18, 2001, on a last-lap Noun during the Daytona 500. He has left a strong Noun in the sport and was one of the inaugural Noun - Plural into the NASCAR Hall of Fame in 2010.
