# Nuclear Abolition

The service coincided with the 50th anniversary of the second Soka Gakkai President Josei Toda's historic "Declaration the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Ends in EST of Nuclear Weapons" on September 8, 1957, in Yokohama. Stating that the atomic bomb is a manifestation of the evil tendency that lurks in human life itself, Mr. Toda earnestly called on youth to take on the mission of working for the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of nuclear weapons and protecting people's inviolable right to life. The memorial service reflected this legacy. Following a choral performance, \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Ends in EST from the world peace prayer monument erected at the Chugoku Peace Memorial Cemetery Park in Hiroshima were read aloud. Soka Gakkai leaders in Hiroshima reaffirmed their ceaseless commitment to realizing a nucl
