Sylvester Manor

In 1652 Sylvester manor was settled. Today, we actively cultivate four acres in <u>Noun-Plural</u>, <u>Noun-Plural</u> and <u>Noun-Plural</u> without the use of chemical pesticides, visible in our bucolic Windmill Field on Manwaring Road. More farming is occurring elsewhere on the property. The <u>Adjective</u> Big Field in our northeast corner was plowed for the first time in decades last fall and planted with cover crop. This spring, we will begin <u>Verb-Present Tense</u> our eastern old fields, long out of cultivation and part of the 83 acres of land preserved forever as farmland in 2012. The Hidden Field, site of the 2011 Plant & Sing Festival, will provide <u>Adjective</u> pastureland for our livestock this year and beyond. <u>Adjective - Comparative</u> fields and <u>Adjective</u> areas will also be cultivated as our farm planning advances.
