# Edward Snowden Letter

One week ago I left Hong Kong after it became clear that my \_\_\_\_\_ and safety were under threat for revealing the truth. My continued \_\_\_\_\_ has been owed to the efforts of \_\_\_\_\_ new and old, family, and others who I have never met and probably never will.
