The year is 1924 and 14 Jewish teens are pledging Alpha Zeta Alpha. Once the brothers of Alpha Zeta Alpha

Verb - Past Tense of these boys' religion they kicked out of the fraternity. In a Noun, the boys formed the Alpha Zadiek Alpha to hold the letters of AZA. They set up Noun Chapter number one, in Omaha Nebraska with the first advisor Sam Beber. But Sam Beber wanted Adverb - Comparative. He wanted a place where all Jewish teens can find security, faith, education, and enjoyment. When the Third Reich took Noun of Europe fewer boys were Verb - Present Tense college. Sam Beber along with B'nai Brith moved AZA to the high school fraternity it is Adverb, still Verb - Present Tense of his goal.

Twenty-Years have passed since the Preposition or subordinating conjunction of the Aleph Zadiek Aleph and B'nai Brith's support. A women named Anita Perlman stood before the international board of directors of B'nai Brith to Verb a girl sorority Verb - Past Tense with AZA and Verb - Past Participle by B'nai Brith. Thus the B'nai Brith Girls were Verb - Past Participle, and together with the Aleph Zadiek Aleph they were BBYO.
