Adaptation

An adaptation, also called an Adjective trait, in biology is a trait with a current Adjective role in the life history of an Noun that is Verb - Past Tense and evolved by means of natural selection.

Adaptation refers to both the current state of being adapted and to the dynamic evolutionary process that leads to the adaptation. Adaptations contribute to the fitness and survival of Noun - Plural. Organisms face a succession of environmental Noun - Plural as they Verb - Base Form and develop and are equipped with an adaptive plasticity as the phenotype of traits Verb - Base Form in response to the imposed conditions. The developmental norm of reaction for any given trait is essential to the correction of adaptation as it affords a kind of biological insurance or resilience to varying environments.
