Poe's Childhood

Edgar Poe was born in Boston on January 19, 1809. That makes him <u>Proper Noun</u>, on the cusp of Aquarius. His parents were David and Elizabeth Poe. David was <u>Verb - Past Participle</u> in <u>Proper Noun</u> on July 18, 1784. Elizabeth Arnold came to the U.S. from <u>Proper Noun</u> in 1796 and married David Poe after her first husband <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> in 1805. They had three <u>Noun - Plural</u>, Henry, Edgar, and Rosalie.

Elizabeth Poe died in <u>Adverb</u>, when Edgar was 2 years old. She had separated from her husband and had taken her <u>Number</u> <u>Noun - Plural</u> with her. Henry went to <u>Verb</u> with his grandparents while Edgar was <u>Verb - Past Participle</u> by Mr. and Mrs. John Allan and Rosalie was taken in by another

family. John Allan was a successful merchant, so Edgar grew up in good surroundings and went to good schools.
