# Lois Lowry

My books have varied in \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective and style. Yet it seems that all of them \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form, essentially, with the same general \_\_\_\_\_ Noun: the importance of human \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural. A Summer to Die, my first book, was a highly fictionalized retelling of the early \_\_\_\_\_ Noun of my sister, and of the effect of such a loss on a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. Number the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural, set in a different \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and era, tells the same \_\_\_\_\_ Noun: that of the role that we \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural play in the lives of our fellow \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural.

The Giver - and the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective books that follow it and make a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun (soon to be a quartet! I've just \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense the fourth book!), Gathering Blue and Messenger - take place \_\_\_\_\_ Preposition or subordinating conjunction the background of very \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective cultures and times. Though they are \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Comparative in scope than my \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective - Comparative books, they nonetheless \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form to the same concern: the vital need of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural to be aware of their interdependence, not only with each other, but with the \_\_\_\_\_ Proper Noun and its \_\_\_\_\_ Noun.
