Abraham Lincoln

Abraham Lincoln was the 16th President of the United States. As an outspoken opponent of the
ending in ing of Plural noun and a political leader in the western states, he won the Republican Party
nomination in 1860 and was elected president later that year.
Lincoln helped preserve the United States by leading the defeat of theConfederacy in the
American Civil War. He introduced measures that resulted in the abolition of issuing his
Emancipation Proclamation in 1863 and promoting the passage of the Thirteenth Amendment to the Constitution
in 1865.
His formal education consisted of aboutmonths of schooling from unofficial teachers. In effect
he was self-educated, studying everyhe could borrow. He mastered the Bible, William
Shakespeare's works, English history andhistory, and developed a plain writing style that
puzzled audiences. He avoided hunting andbecause he did not like killing animals even
for food and, though unusually tall and spent so much time reading that some neighbors
suspected he must be doing it to avoid Verb ending in ing Adjective Plural noun.
