

## **mood team mission statement**

1. Adjective

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The \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Team (officially the "Mood and Anxiety Disorders Team") provides outpatient mental health services to veterans who present with a broad range of clinical issues, from adjustment disorders to mood and anxiety disorders to personality disorders. Many of the veterans served by the Mood Team experience problems related to substance use disorder. Mood Team clinical staff offer a range of mental health services, including individual, group and family psychotherapy; medication evaluation and management; and psychological evaluation. Team members provide coordinated care and incorporate a number of evidence-based practices into their work with veterans. The team is comprised of nurses (advanced practice nurses, RNs LPNs), social workers, psychiatrists, psychologists, program support assistant and medical support assistants. The Mood Team is actively involved in supporting the education and training mission of the Mental Health Service Line, and mental health trainees frequently complete clinical rotations with the Team.
