American Idol is an annual American televised Verb ending in ing competition, which began its first season on June 11, 2002. The program seeks to Verb the best young singer in the country, through a series of nationwide auditions. The outcomes of the latter stages of this competition is wholly determined by Adjective Plural noun. The format features three judges who critique the contestants' performances in order to facilitate the voting.

The first season of American Idol debuted without hype as a summer replacement show on Fox after being rejected by numerous other Plural noun. Through word of mouth generated by the appeal of its contestants and the presence of Adjective judge Simon Cowell, the show grew into a phenomenon. An estimated fifty million Plural noun watched the Season 1 finale in September 2002.
