<u>First Name of a Person</u> Foote Hawley was the <u>Adjective - Ends in EST</u> child of <u>First Name of a Person</u> Augustus Foote. She was born in 1831 on June 25th in <u>Location</u>. Throughout January 2, 1863 and February 7, 1864, <u>First Name of a Person</u> Foote Hawley <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> seven newspaper articles about her experiences in the South during the Civil War , four of which were <u>Verb - Past Tense</u> while her husband who was serving in Florida.
