# 5 TRICKS THAT WILL MAKE YOUR IPHONE RUN MUCH SMOOTHER

Here is a list of five simple tips and tricks that Apple device owners can use in order to improve the performance

and overall user experience on their devices. These tricks are especially important for people who own

Adjective iPhones and iPads - all of the new features in Apple's recent iOS updates bring additional heft

to the platform that can really slow Repeat Last Adjective hardware down.

1. Get rid of Noun - Plural you don't need.

Users should be aware of what's on their phone and to clear out Repeat Last Noun - Plural that are no longer in use.

To check your usage, go to Settings, then General, then scroll down and click Usage. It might take a minute to

load, but you'll be able to see which Repeat Last Noun - Plural are taking up the most space on your iPhone. Then,

Verb - Base Form what you can. That weird Noun you never Verb - Base Form might actually

be taking up a ton of space on your phone. Trash it!

2. Treat it like a Noun and Verb - Base Form your Noun - Possessive Noun.

When you Repeat Last Verb - Base Form your Repeat Last Noun - Possessive Repeat Last Noun and Noun - Plural

you can actually have an impact on performance, believe it or not. To do this, go to Settings, then Safari, then

Repeat Last Verb - Base Form Repeat Last Noun and Repeat Last Verb - Base Form Repeat Last Noun - Plural.

3.

DELETE old TEXTS.

ADJ SMS users can definitely clear some space when they DELETE old TEXTS that are no longer needed.

Simply VERB a NOUN, and then tap and hold a ADJ NOUN until you see the 'MADEUP' option pop up. Then tap 'DELETE everything.'

4. Turn off auto APP updates.

Most people enjoy getting their hands on new features afforded by APP updates, but if NOUNS are your top priority, disabling those updates might be a good idea. To turn off auto APP updates, go to Settings, then VERB.

There, VERB all of the buttons to the left to turn off automatic APP downloads.

5. Turn off Location Services.

This tip is important not just for speed, but also for NOUNS and privacy. A lot of apps use Location Services to determine where you ARE, and it's generally not necessary. Go to Settings, then Privacy, then Location Services. From there, you can choose to VERB it ADV or just turn it off. Some apps obviously need your NOUNS to best serve you. But many, like Facebook, don't need to know where you ARE. Turn off Location Services for apps that don't necessitate it.
