# Cheese

The rosters for the 2014 Proper Noun Game were officially announced during a Adjective broadcast on Sunday night. As a reminder, the Adjective position players are Verb - Past Tense by the fans while the rest of the rosters are voted on by Noun - Plural and selected by All-Star Noun - Plural John Farrell (Red Sox) and Mike Matheny (Cardinals).

The All-Star rosters Verb - Base Form 34 players deep, but only 33 players for each team were Verb - Past Tense Sunday. The final spot is up for grabs via the Final Vote fan voting. Any starting pitchers who Verb - Base Form Sunday, July 13, are not Adjective to pitch in the All-Star Game itself, which will be played at Target Field in Minneapolis on Tuesday, July 15. The Home Run Derby will be played the day before, and the Futures Game the day before that.

All 30 teams get at least one Determiner in the All-Star Game. Keep in mind that injured players will be Verb - Past Participle on the rosters between now and then. Here is an update of the rosters as they are announced:
