Gaston Lachaise was born in Paris, the Noun of a master Noun -maker and wood Verb - Base Form (-er). He emigrated from France in 1906, Verb - Present ends in ING in New York where he established a studio. He is most renowned for his sculptures of Noun - Plural -- Verb - Present ends in ING, Present ends in ING, Verb - Present ends in ING, seated or Verb - Present ends in ING -- who are rendered as Adjective goddesses and images of exalted Noun. This sculpture Verb - Present ends in S Lachaise's typical simplification of Noun and Adjective approach to the human body. Lachaise Verb - Past Tense a similar minimalist approach is his drawings as evident in the Noun sketch included in this exhibition.
