oxymoron: figure of speech when two Adjective words provide a meaning

Examples: First Name of a Person had been told many times that she looked almost exactly like model Kate Upton.

hyperbole: use of exaggeration to emphasize an idea

Examples: We Verb - Past Tense in the Adjective Noun for what seemed like Number centuries.

It felt like it was just yesterday when he Verb - Past Tense the love of his life at the school Event.

alliteration: occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of closely connected words
