| What is a misplaced modifier, you ask? A misplaced modifier is a word, phrase or clause that is improperly |

| separated from the word it describes. Because of the separation, sentences with this error often sound |

| A dangling modifier is a phrase or clause that is not clearly and logically related to the word or words it modifies |
| (i.e. is placed next to). |
| Two notes about dangling modifiers: |
| - Unlike a misplaced modifier, a dangling modifier cannot be corrected by simply moving it to a different place in a sentence. |
| - In most cases, the dangling modifier appears at the beginning of the sentence, although it can also come at the |
| end. Sometimes the dangling modifier error occurs because the sentence fails to anything |
| to which the modifier can refer. |
