The Vine and the Branches

1 "I am the true Noun, and my Father is the Noun. 2 He cuts off every branch in me that third person verb followed by direct object no Noun, while every branch that does verb - base form followed by direct object Noun he Verb - Present ends in S so that it will be even more Adjective. 3 You are already Adjective because of the word I have spoken to you. 4 Remain in me, as I also Verb - Base Form in you. No Noun can bear Noun by itself; it must remain in the Noun. Neither can you verb - base form followed by direct object fruit unless you remain in me.

5 "I am the Noun; you are the Noun - Plural. If you Verb - Base Form in me and I in you, you will Verb - Base Form much fruit; apart from me you can do Activity. 6 If you do not remain in me, you are like a Noun that is thrown away and Passive Verb; such Noun are picked up, thrown into the Noun and Passive Verb. 7 If you remain in me and my Noun - Plural remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 This is to my Father's Noun, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my Noun - Plural.
