# Jonah 1:1-16

## Jonah Flees From the Lord

1 The \_\_\_\_\_  
Noun of the Lord came to Jonah son of \_\_\_\_\_  
Famous person: 2 "Go to the \_\_\_\_\_  
Adjective city of \_\_\_\_\_  
City name and preach against it, because its \_\_\_\_\_  
Noun has come up before me."

3 But Jonah ran away from the Lord and headed for \_\_\_\_\_

They cast \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural and the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun fell on Jonah. 8 So they asked him, "Tell us, who is responsible for making all this trouble for us? What kind of work do you do? Where do you come from? What is your country? From what people are you?"

9 He answered, "I am a \_\_\_\_\_ Nationality and I worship the Lord, the God of \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, who made the sea and the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun."

10 This terrified them and they asked, "What have you done?" (They knew he was \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present ends in ING from the Lord, because he had already told them so.)

11 The sea was getting \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective ending in er and \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective ending in er. So they asked him, "What should we \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - followed by Direct Object to you to make the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun calm down for us?"

12 " \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - followed by Direct Object me up and \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - followed by Direct Object me into the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun," he replied, "and it will become \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective. I know that it is my fault that this \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun has come upon you."

13 Instead, the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural did their best to \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form back to land. But they could not, for the

\_\_\_\_\_ Noun grew even \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective ending in er than before. 14 Then they cried out to the \_\_\_\_\_ Title for a

\_\_\_\_\_ Verb - followed by Direct Object him overboard, and the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective sea grew \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective. 16 At this  
the men \_\_\_\_\_ Adverb \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - followed by Direct Object the Lord, and they offered a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun to the Lord  
and made \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural to him.
