Mixtures and Solutions

A mixture is two or more Noun which will retain their physical Noun when combined. For example, a tossed salad is a Noun because, even though the lettuce and the dressing and the veggies Verb - Base Form to make a salad, it is still clear what they individually are, also trail mix because it is a mixture of many different things that you can tell apart very Adverb.

A solution is a mixture of two or more substances in which one substance completely Verb - Present ends in S into another. For example, sweet tea is a solution because the sugar Adverb dissolves into the tea, also Kool-Aid can dissolve into water.

A mixture is just Adjective or more objects mixed together. A solution is a type of mixture in which the Noun dissolves in the solvent.

a solution cannot be Verb - Past Tense by physical means such as a filter.
