## **CAN SPAM Act**

Any opt-out mechanism you offer must be able to process opt-out requests for at least <u>Number</u> days after you send your message. You must honor a recipient's opt-out request within <u>Number</u> business days. You can't charge a fee, require the recipient to give you any personally <u>Verb Present Tense</u> information beyond an email address, or make the recipient take any step other than sending a reply <u>Noun</u> or visiting a single page on an Internet website as a condition for honoring an opt-out <u>Noun</u>. Once people have told you they don't want to receive more <u>Noun Plural</u> from you, you can't sell or transfer their email addresses , even in the form of a <u>Noun</u> list. The only exception is that you may transfer the addresses to a company you've hired to help you comply with the <u>Proper Noun</u> Act.
