# CAN SPAM Act

Any opt-out mechanism you offer must be able to process opt-out requests for at least \_\_\_\_\_ Number days after you send your message. You must honor a recipient's opt-out request within \_\_\_\_\_ Number business days. You can't charge a fee, require the recipient to give you any personally \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Present Tense information beyond an email address, or make the recipient take any step other than sending a reply \_\_\_\_\_ Noun or visiting a single page on an Internet website as a condition for honoring an opt-out \_\_\_\_\_ Noun. Once people have told you they don't want to receive more \_\_\_\_\_ Noun - Plural from you, you can't sell or transfer their email addresses, even in the form of a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun list. The only exception is that you may transfer the addresses to a company you've hired to help you comply with the \_\_\_\_\_ Proper Noun Act.
