Pink Floyd were an _____ Nationality _____ Genre of Music band formed in London. They achieved international acclaim with their _____ Specific Type of Music and _____ Specific Type of Music music. Distinguished by their use of _____ Adjective lyrics, sonic _____ Verb - Present ends in ING, extended _____ Noun - Plural and elaborate live shows, they are one of the most commercially successful and musically _____ Adjective groups in the history of _____ Adjective music.

Pink Floyd was founded in _____ Year by students Syd Barrett, Nick Mason, Roger Waters, and Richard Wright. They gained popularity _____ Verb - Present ends in ING in London's underground music scene during the late _____ Decade, and under Barrett's leadership released _____ Number charting singles and a successful debut album, The _____ Noun at the Gates of Dawn (1967). David Gilmour joined as a _____ Number member in December 1967; Barrett left the band in _____ Month 1968 due to deteriorating _____ Adjective health. Waters became the band's primary lyricist and, by the _____ Decade, their dominant songwriter, devising the _____ Noun - Plural behind their critically and commercially successful albums The _____ Color Side of the Moon (1973), Wish You Were Here (1975), _____ Noun - Plural (1977), The _____ Noun (1979) and The Final Cut (1983).

Wright left Pink Floyd in 1979, followed by Waters in 1985, declaring it a "_____ Adjective _____ Noun".

Gilmour and Mason continued as Pink Floyd; Wright rejoined them as a _____ Adjective musician and, later, a band

member. The three produced _____ Number more albums, A _____ Adjective Lapse of _____ Noun (1987) and The Division _____ Noun (1994), and toured until _____ Year. After nearly two decades of acrimony, Pink Floyd reunited with Waters in _____ Year for a performance at the global awareness event Live _____ Number, but Gilmour and Waters have since stated they have no plans to reunite as a band again. Barrett died in _____ Year and Wright in 2008. A new Pink Floyd studio album recorded without Waters partially originating from _____ Noun - Plural recorded in 1993-1994, The Endless _____ Noun, was released in _____ Month 2014.

Pink Floyd was inducted into the _____ Country Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1996, and the _____ Country Music Hall of Fame in 2005. By 2013, the band had sold more than _____ Number million records worldwide, including 74.5 million certified units in the United _____ Noun - Plural.
