Wright left Pink Floyd in 1979, followed by Waters in 1985, declaring it a " _____ Adjective _____ _____ Noun _____ ". Gilmour and Mason continued as Pink Floyd; Wright rejoined them as a _____ Adjective _____ musician and, later, a band

member. The three produced _____ Number more albums, A _____ Adjective Lapse of _____ Noun (1987)

and The Division _____ Noun (1994), and toured until _____ Year. After nearly two decades of acrimony,

Pink Floyd reunited with Waters in _____ Year for a performance at the global awareness event Live
