Kim Dae-Jung was born on December 3, Year. He worked as a Noun in a Japanese shipping, but eventually Verb - Past Tense over the company in Year, becoming a Adjective Noun. He was Verb - Past Tense by Noun - Plural in the Korean War and was sentenced to death, but managed to escape. In Year he became the Noun of the National Democratic party. Nobel Noun Prize recipient in Year. He was called the "Nelson Mandela of Location" for his long-standing opposition to authoritarian rule for his Sunshine Policy towards North Location. The Sunshine policy was the foreign Noun of South Korea towards North Korea from 1998-2007. He Verb - Past Tense an honorary Noun at the University of Location on April 17 2008, where he delivered his speech, "Noun, Noun, and Noun." Kim died on August 2009 from multiple Noun dysfunction syndrome at Severance Hospital of Yonsei University in Seoul.
