Joseph Robinette "Joe" Biden, Jr. (born November 20, 1942) is the 47th and current Vice President of the United States, jointly elected with _____ Noun Barack Obama. He is a member of the _____ Adjective Party and was a United States _____ Place from January 3, 1973, until his _____ Noun on January 15, 2009, following his election to the Vice Presidency. In 2012, Biden was _____ Verb - Past Participle to a second _____ Noun alongside Obama.

Biden was born in _____ Place, and lived there for _____ Number years before moving to _____ Place.

He became an _____ Noun in _____ Year, and was elected to the New Castle County council in 1970.

Biden was first elected to the Senate in 1972 and became the sixth-youngest _____ Noun in U.S. history. He

was re-elected to the Senate _____ Number times, and was the fourth most senior _____ Noun at the time of

his resignation. Biden was a long-time member and former chairman of the _____ Noun Committee. His

strong advocacy helped bring about U.S. military _____ Noun and _____ Noun during the Bosnian War. He

_____ Verb - Past Tense the Gulf War in 1991. He voted in favor of the Iraq War Resolution in 2002, but later

proposed resolutions to alter U.S. strategy there. He has also served as chairman of the Senate _____ Noun

Committee, dealing with issues related to _____ Noun policy, _____ Noun, and _____ Noun, and led

creation of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act and Violence Against Women Act. He chaired

the Judiciary Committee during the _____ Adjective U.S. Supreme Court nominations of _____ Person and

Biden unsuccessfully sought the Democratic presidential nomination in _____^{Year} and _____^{Year}, both times dropping out early in the race. Barack Obama selected Biden to be the Democratic Party nominee for Vice President in the 2008 U.S. presidential election. Biden is the first _____^{Noun} and the first _____^{Noun} to become Vice President of the United States. As Vice President, Biden has been heavily involved in Obama's decision-making process and _____^{Verb - Past Tense} the oversight role for _____^{Noun} spending from the Obama stimulus package aimed at counteracting the late-2000s recession. His ability to _____^{Verb} with Congressional Republicans played a key role in bringing about the bipartisan deals that resulted in the Tax Relief , Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization, and Job Creation Act of _____^{Year} that resolved a _____^{Noun} deadlock, the Budget Control Act of 2011 that resolved that year's debt ceiling crisis, and the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 that addressed the impending " _____^{Adjective} cliff". Obama and Biden were re-elected in 2012.
