# My Date With the Vice President's Daughter

Joseph Robinette "Joe" Biden, Jr. (born November 20, 1942) is the 47th and current Vice President of the United States, jointly elected with \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Barack Obama. He is a member of the \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective Party and was a United States \_\_\_\_\_ Place from January 3, 1973, until his \_\_\_\_\_ Noun on January 15, 2009, following his election to the Vice Presidency. In 2012, Biden was \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Participle to a second \_\_\_\_\_ Noun alongside Obama.

Biden was first elected to the Senate in 1972 and became the sixth-youngest \_\_\_\_\_ Noun in U.S. history. Biden was a long-time member and former chairman of the \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Committee. His strong advocacy helped bring about U.S. military \_\_\_\_\_ Noun and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun during the Bosnian War. He \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Past Tense the Gulf War in 1991. He voted in favor of the Iraq War Resolution in 2002, but later proposed resolutions to alter U.S. strategy there. He has also served as chairman of the Senate \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Committee, dealing with issues related to \_\_\_\_\_ Noun policy, \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, and \_\_\_\_\_ Noun, and led creation of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act and Violence Against Women Act. Biden unsuccessfully sought the Democratic presidential nomination in \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup> and \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup>, both times dropping out early in the race. Barack Obama selected Biden to be the Democratic Party nominee for Vice President in the 2008 U.S. presidential election. His ability to \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Verb</sup> with Congressional Republicans played a key role in bringing about the bipartisan deals that resulted in the Tax Relief , Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization, and Job Creation Act of \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Year</sup> that resolved a \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Noun</sup> deadlock, the Budget Control Act of 2011 that resolved that year's debt ceiling crisis, and the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 that addressed the impending " \_\_\_\_\_<sup>Adjective</sup> cliff". Obama and Biden were re-elected in 2012.
