A Cup of Tea

Add Number to Number teaspoons of Adjective tea leaves for every 6 ounces of water.

Add Number teaspoon for the teapot. Bring more than enough Adjective or bottled water to a boil. For Adjective or Adjective Tea, let the Noun Adjective 30-60 secs before Verb - Present ends in ING.

An Adjective teapot can draw the Adjective from your tea, especially during the Adjective months. Verb - Present ends in ING the Noun prior to Verb - Present ends in ING the Noun is Adjective Noun for many Noun drinkers and is an Adjective method for keeping the tea Adjective longer. Verb - Base Form or Verb - Base Form the Noun in a sink of Adjective Noun from the Noun. This should not be the Noun that you intend to Verb - Base Form the tea from. You may add water heated on the Noun to raise the Noun if you like. Verb - Base Form the water around the Noun to Verb - Base Form that all Noun - Plural have been warmed. Verb - Base Form out just before you Verb - Base Form to pour the Noun into the Noun.

Add the hot Noun to the tea Noun. Let the tea steep for Number (Adjective Noun) to Number (Noun) minutes. Verb - Present ends in ING on your tastes you may want to serve tea with Food, sugar, Noun or honey. Do not serve tea with both Repeat Last Food and Repeat Last Food, or the Repeat Last Food will curdle. If you use Repeat Last Food, add the Repeat Last Food to the cup first then add the tea; this prevents the hot tea from Verb - Present ends in ING the Repeat Last Food.
