How to Prune a Tree

Let's look at a few pruning tips to keep your trees _____ Adjective and aesthetically pleasing.

THE THREE STEP CUT

1) Make a _____ Adjective cut on the underside of the branch about _____ Number inches from the stem. This will prevent a tear during step 2 from running into the stem of the branch.

2) Make another Repeat Last Adjective cut one foot from the stem.

3) Remove the remaining _____ Number foot stub at the stem.

WHEN TO PRUNE

Remove _____ Adjective branches anytime, but wait until the end of fall to _____ Verb - Base Form

_____ Adjective branches. Trees are more _____ Adjective during this time and sap loss will be minimal.

Don't Repeat Last Verb - Base Form every branch at once. Spread the pruning out over a couple seasons to reduce the stress

on the tree.
