How to Prune a Tree

Let's look at a few pruning tips to keep your trees and aesthetically pleasing.
THE THREE STEP CUT
1) Make a cut on the underside of the branch about inches from the stem. This will prevent a tear during step 2 from running into the stem of the branch.
2) Make another Repeat Last Adjective cut one foot from the stem.
3) Remove the remaining foot stub at the stem.
WHEN TO PRUNE
Remove branches anytime, but wait until the end of fall to verb - Base Form Adjective branches. Trees are more Adjective during this time and sap loss will be minimal.
Don't Repeat Last Verb - Base Form every branch at once. Spread the pruning out over a couple seasons to reduce the
