World Wrestling Entertainment has removed wrestler Hulk Hogan from its \_\_\_\_\_ Location after audio surfaced of the Hulkster saying the " \_\_\_\_\_ Noun " in an interview on the Sirius XM radio station "Shade 45?" in 2012, The Daily Beast reports.

In the interview with DJ \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ Noun on the " \_\_\_\_\_ Noun Shuffle" show, Hogan explains the origin of his habitual use of "brother" and if any \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective guys ever called him "nigga":
