Change a \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ or coworker's tech \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ Adjective \_\_\_\_\_ language. Get hold of their Facebook, phone or \_\_\_\_\_ Noun \_\_\_\_\_ and change all the settings to Latin, or Spanish, or German, anything they don't \_\_\_\_\_ Verb - Base Form \_\_\_\_\_.

If you're feeling extra Adjective, put a Adjective Noun on the underside of the Noun so they know who's Adjective.

Cover a Noun with saran wrap. You will only want to cover the upper part of the Noun, otherwise their Part of Body will Verb - Base Form the wrap instead of their Part of Body. Also you need to pull the saran wrap taut to Verb - Base Form it, otherwise your victim will Verb - Base Form it. Enlist a First Name of a Person to help.

If someone Verb - Present ends in S away from their Noun - Plural or stops Verb - Present ends in ING their phone, ask to Verb - Base Form your parents. Then make sure the colleague is Verb - Present ends in ING their Noun - Plural.

Tell a friend their teacher wants to see them. If you go to a Adjective school, tell a friend that a teacher wants you at their Location ASAP. You could even make a Noun from him/her to make it seem Adjective. Your friend will have to Verb - Base Form all the way to the teachers office only to find they've been Verb - Past Tense.

Before your target goes to Location, Verb - Base Form Preposition the bed with a Adjective clothing or a Adjective hand (optional). While they Verb - Base Form Preposition to the Noun, grab their Part of Body! It will be Adjective watching them Verb - Base Form and try to break free, but don't Verb - Base Form the prank by Verb - Present ends in ING, or Verb - Present ends in ING yourself.
